



Citizenship Language Pack For Migrants in Europe



The first piloting version of the **"L- Pack: Citizenship Language Pack for Migrants in Europe"** is ready for migrants and teachers who need professional and efficient language training materials. The three universities and four adult training organisations in Europe that run the project have designed instructional material for adult migrants in 6 European languages: **German, Italian, Spanish, Czech, modern Greek and Lithuanian.**

The complete language learning materials **for each of these languages** consist of

- 60 short **videos**
- 60 **text dialogues and exercises** related to everyday life
- 60 **audio-files**
- language and country information

These materials and also the guides "How to use L-Pack" (one for teachers and one for students' self-learning) are now available on the L-Pack website (www.l-pack.eu). All students and teachers are kindly advised to consult these guides in advance in order to successfully support the teaching-learning process and improve their language skills in classroom or independently.

Additionally, L-Pack Project's channel was created on **You Tube** where all those interested in the project can find the first versions of the videos corresponding to the dialogues of the L-Pack manual and they can effectively learn and practice specific vocabulary and language structures. Thus, the teachers will have reliable teaching resources to work with and the students will also be involved in self-correction, being able to improve their performance and monitor their own progress. The materials are specially designed for adult migrants who have only basic knowledge of national language and want to improve their language skills according to level A2 set by the Common European framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). The L-Pack materials provide them with the necessary **colloquial language structures** in order to facilitate their social and cultural integration. The vocabulary comprises terms from various areas of general interest for migrants such as: "Authorities", "Communication", "Family and Socialising", "Health", "Job Hunting", "Leisure Time", "Looking for Accommodation", "School", "Self Education", "Shopping", "Travelling" and "Working Life." The students will learn how to use the appropriate language in particular situations and they will be able to adapt and practice their vocabulary according to everyday life.

In order to adapt the teaching and learning products of each language version to the needs of migrant learners **pilot tests** will be conducted in all partner countries in spring 2012. Therefore special trainers' workshops were held at the beginning of the year.
