**- How often do you use the tool?**

There are many image storage services but none like this. You have an almost infinite space. Perhaps a problem is that it does not manage well, the copyright.

**- For what purpose?**

Flickr is a photography tool. As an environmental teacher I was in need of a tool to allow me to share and keep large amounts of pics. I found it using Google but it was also recommended by a friend of mine.

This tool allows you to store 1Tb of data without using your hard disk space. I can create “lighter” powerpoint presentations just linking images to the slides.



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
