



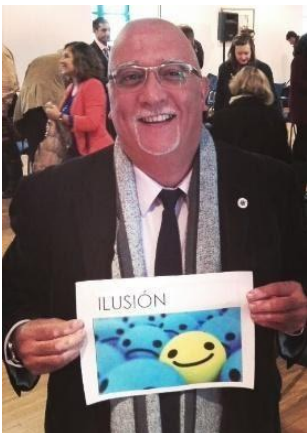

- How often do you use the tool?

I use the tool for every occasion that I want to transmit something in a visual way, generally as a supportive tool for other formative actions. I also use it to announce events, activities, courses, meetings, etc. I think Animaker can be used in every activity related with traineeship, even in labour environments.

- For what purpose?

Basically, I use the tool in an online formative environment and as a complement for other formative actions. Also, it can be used for creating “formative pills” about a subject which could be divided into brief and complementary messages.

- What tip would you give to other teachers regarding this tool?

You should structure the main message carefully, by dividing it into small pieces and making a good script that allows to build an effective and entertaining message which may reach the target audience in an easy and enjoyable way, not losing in any case the rigour of the information it contains.

I often use ANIMAKER, it is an excellent substitute for Toondoo, which is sadly not online anymore.

- What tip would you give to other teachers regarding this tool?

Using drag & drop and the storyline tool, universal by now, anyone who has a little confidence with animating software can't not appreciate how easy to use ANIMAKER is. To take advantage of all the tools and particularly of the huge templates that are available you have to give up the free version – which also limits the number of videos you can export and work on – and upgrade to premium.

- For what purpose?

ANIMAKER makes it possible to create explanatory videos in an easy and intuitive way. So I used the tool, which works well with PREZI, to complete e-learning processes, to generate informal presentations and also to create interactive stories.



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
