- How often do you use the tool?

A few times per year. I know this tool for almost 2 years now and it helps me to engage students to a certain topic.

- What tip would you give to other teachers regarding this tool?

It is a tool to keep in the back of your head and use it when you have to give a (boring) presentation to your students. It is a fun way to receive responses from your students and it will engage students (when using a recognizable GIF) to your topic. Don't use it too much and only in your presentations.

- For what purpose?
